Non-GMO Seed Project Receives Funding from Save the Earth

C ave the Earth Foundation (STE) recently **O**announced its funding of a community nursery managed by Nick Routledge at Canticle Farms in Oakland CA, a non-profit urban farming and gardening initiative. The seed money granted by STE will go towards the purchase of public domain, open-pollinated, non-hybrid, non-GMO seed, soil, containers and irrigation equipment to raise seedlings for distribution in East Bay neighborhoods along with providing training to grow food. The goal supply fresh, high-quality to produce is to urban neighborhoods that are typically deprived of supporting the installation good food by of home-based kitchen gardens.

Save the Earth Collaborates with California Central Coast Research Institutes to Explore Davidson Seamount, May 2015




Save the Earth's most recent collaboration will support a nine-day research cruise aboard the NOAA survey vessel, *Bell M. Shimada*, to characterize fish, birds and

mammals of the Davidson Seamount: evaluate the strengths and weaknesses of different marine mammal sampling techniques; and support the development of a Marine Biodiversity Observatory Network. Along with standard sampling techniques using human observers and nets, airplane drones will make remote observations and floating hydrophones will detect whale and human sounds (which can travel across the ocean). Environmental DNA will also be collected as part of this cutting-edge research which will revolutionize how scientists and resource managers assess oceans. In a simple water sample, DNA from organisms that swim by can be used to assess what has been in the area. Keep an eye on STE's Facebook page and the media in mid-May for spectacular images and preliminary results of this fascinating research project.

Download the PSA and send it off to YOUR local radio station and ask them to put it on the air.


