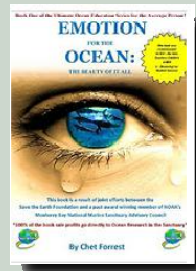

**ST. FRANCIS HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS FUNDED BY STE TO SOLVE ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES; SCHOOL SENDS SAVE THE EARTH FOUNDATION AWARD TO POPE FRANCIS IN THE VATICAN.**

Save The Earth Foundation held a video contest at St. Francis High School in Watsonville, California.

The contestants were asked to read "Emotion For The Ocean" by Chet Forrest and then make a video on one of the subjects in the book. Winners were given certificates and a Save The Earth pin and keychain. The contest was a prototype for future events and a lot was learned from this initial effort. Students were asked to create videos that were 5 minutes or less, but in retrospect it was realized that 30 second videos could be used as PSAs on TV and radio. The next contest will now focus on 30 seconds or less video spots which will be used to further the message of saving our earth.



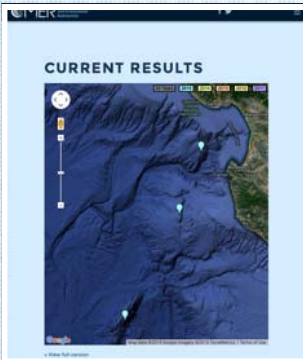
Marissa DeVogelaere, a key member of the school's Ecology Club, is pictured here with the new Hydration Station.

In addition to the school's recycling program, STE and NOAA's Ocean Guardian Program helped the school's Ecology Club to install a new Hydration System reducing the use of, and saving the ocean from, single-use plastic bottles.

access to over 1,650 high quality images of over 631 species of marine life of the Monterey Bay National Marine Sanctuary, including over 130 species with detailed ecological information. You can browse by common or scientific name within all species at once, or by large functional group (birds, marine mammals, fishes, invertebrates, and algae).
